Veterans in Crisis is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that aims to address veteran needs across 14 counties in Northern Michigan.


## A Community-Based Effort to Help Veterans in Northern Michigan

Since 2016 we have successfully used a "hand-up" veteran to veteran approach in helping Northern Michigan veterans who have unforeseen needs whether it's a wheelchair ramp that needs construction or a medical issue that a needy veteran cannot financially absorb right now.
